In 1973, Domaine Chandon became the first French-owned sparkling wine venture in the United States. The famous Champagne producer Moët & Chandon and acclaimed cognac maker Hennessy combined forces with the mission of producing world-class sparkling wine in Napa Valley. They identified prime vineyard sites at Mt. Veeder, in Carneros and Yountville, the location Domaine Chandon now calls home.
